- * 24 count Crayola colored pencils (Already sharpened-in box)
- * Small pencil sharpener with shaving collector
- * 10 count Crayola BROAD markers (Classic color)
- 4 black Expo FINE dry erase markers
- 2 black FINE Sharpies (NOT ultra fine)
- Pointed metal scissors
- ✤ 4 large glue sticks (at least .74 oz.)
